

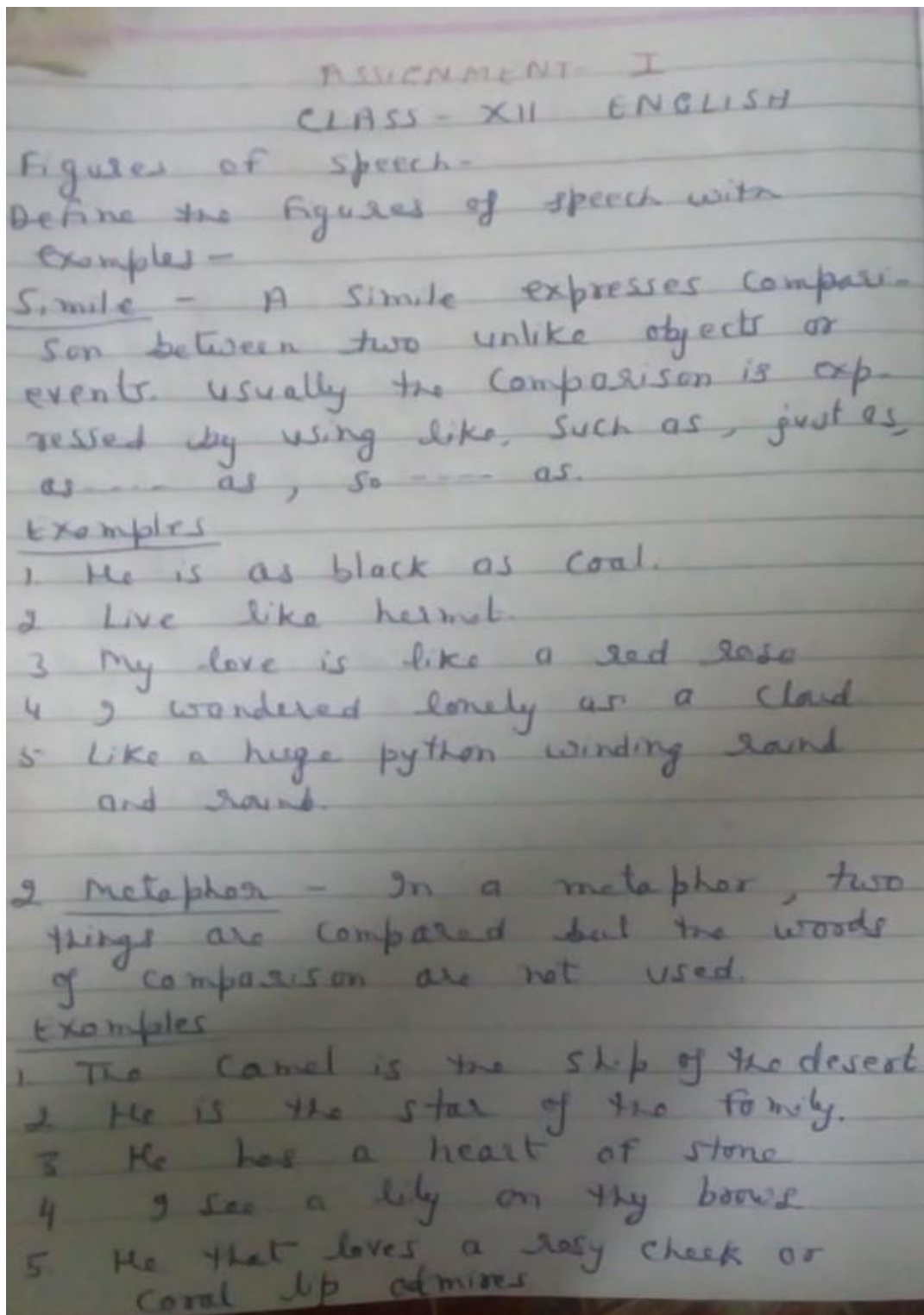

3. Personification. In Personification lifeless objects and abstract ideas are thought of as a living beings.

Examples

1. Experience is the best teacher.
2. Anxiety is sitting on her face.
3. Love is blind.
4. Opportunity knocks at the door but once.
5. Death lays his icy hands even on kings.

4. Apostrophe. In apostrophe, we address a dead person or some lifeless thing or an abstract idea as a living person.

Examples

1. Frailty! Thy name is woman.
2. O Grave! where is thy victory.
3. O mighty Caesar! dost thou lie so low.
4. O Death! where is thy sting?
5. O cuckoo! shall I call the bird.

5. Hyperbole - In Hyperbole, a statement is made emphatic by over statement.

Examples

1. She wept oceans of tears.
2. Rivers of blood flowed in the battle.
3. Ten thousand saw I at a glance.
4. All the perfumes of Arabia will not sweeten this little hand.
5. I have not seen my brother for ages.

6. Oxymoron - In Oxymoron, we find the association of two words or phrases having opposite meanings.

Examples -

1. She is feeling sweet pain.
2. Having nothing he hath all.
3. Why are you regularly irregular in the class?
4. Life is bitter sweet.
5. This is an open secret.

7. Onomatopoeia - An onomatopoeia consists in using a word similar to the sound.

Examples -

1. I heard the water lapping on the crag.
2. I hear the humming of bees.
3. The snakes are hissing and bees are buzzing.
4. Cooing of doves is very pleasant.
5. The curfew tolls the knell of a parting day.
