#### Explanation

\* What is Subject ? :- In every sentence we mention a person, place or thing and then we say something about that person, place or thing.

The person, place or thing we mention is the Subject or we can say that the Part of the Sentence that tells us who or what the sentence is about is called the Subject

Ex. - i) Ram is going to market.

ii) The fisherman is catching the fish.

In above sentences 'Ram' and 'Fisherman' are Subjects.

Predicate :- Whatever we say about the Person or thing is 'Predicate'.

Ex:- 1) Ram is going to market.

In this sentence 'is going to market' is predicate
