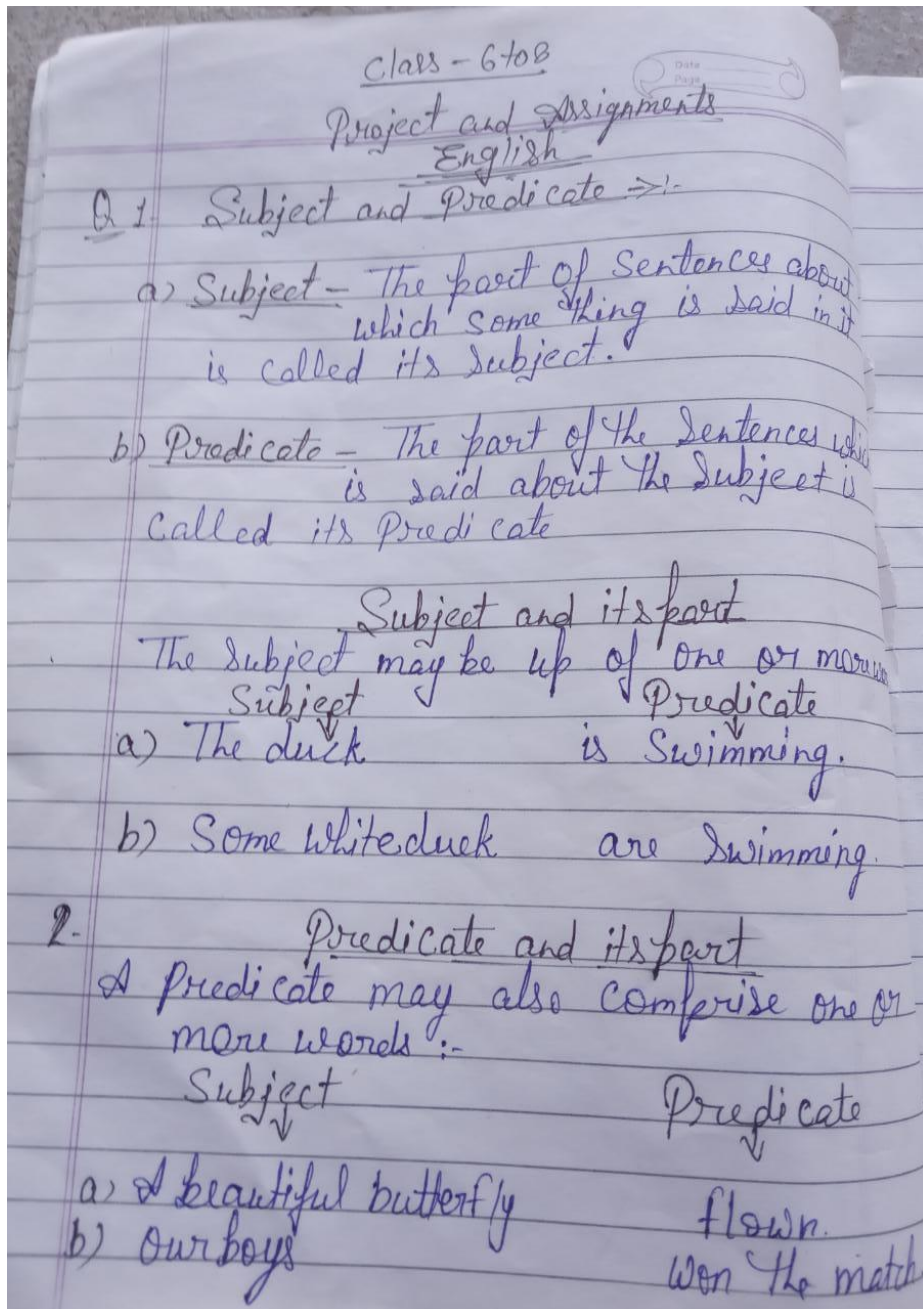

Q 2 -

Noun - Number →

Noun can be used in two Numbers:-

a) Singular Number :- The Singular Number indicates that a Noun is one. Example - Boy, leaf.

b) Plural Number :- The plural Number indicates that a Noun is more than one. Ex - Boys, leaves.

For Examples →

1. A leaf fell from this tree.
Ans - Leaves fell from these trees.

2- Interrogative Sentences- Questions are called Interrogative Sentences. for example-

- ★ Where do you study?
- ★ Were they in the classroom?

3- Imperative Sentences- A sentence that can order or request is called an Imperative sentence. for example.

- ★ Please bring me a glass of water.
- ★ Don't make a noise.

4- Exclamatory Sentences- A sentence that can express some strong or sudden feeling is called an exclamatory sentence; for example

- ★ May you live long!
- ★ Bravo! you have scored the goal.

Type of Sentences →

A Sentences can perform four types of functions So, there are four types of sentences:-

1- Assertive Sentences:- A sentence that states or declares something is called an Assertive sentence. for example

- ★ She is a fine doctor.
- ★ They will appear on the hilltop.

a) Affirmative Sentences or positive Sentences

It affirms a statement, for example

- # We are going to market.

b) Negative Sentences:- It negates something for example

- # We are not going to market.
